to Yeshaya Clair (Chicago). Below is a picture of Yeshaya receiving his prize of a Shas.



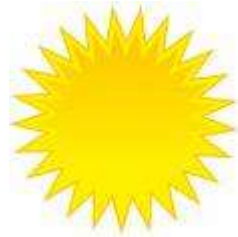
Maseches Pesachim
